Projects will only be graded when they are completed! Projects will be graded using the following criteria, and are each worth 100 points.

Clarity of Message

Classroom Assignments and Activities will be assigned on a semi-regular basis, and will be assigned point values based upon the level of difficulty and allotted time. Students are required to make-up all missed work due to absences. All work is to be done in class unless otherwise approved by the teacher. Students will not be penalized for turning in late projects, however, late projects will only be accepted up to the nearest mid-quarter cut-off.

Sketchbook Assignments will be assigned at the beginning of specified projects. The assigned sketches will require that students plan their design ideas and layouts before designing in Adobe. Points will be assigned to these sketches.

Extra Credit Assignments can only be started after finishing an assigned project early. ONE Extra Credit assignment may be turned in per assigned/completed project, and can be ANYTHING created with the Adobe programs.
